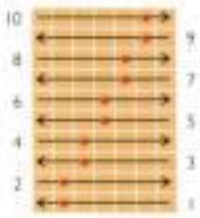


# HOW TO USE THE CHARTS

Working from **charts** has many advantages, the main one being the immediacy with which the relationship between stitches and rows is illustrated. This makes understanding the construction of a stitch pattern and memorizing a repeat much easier. It's also an incentive to adapt existing stitches and invent new ones. Because the number of different symbols used in any one stitch pattern is small, they can be learned a few at a time as required. All the symbols have been chosen to be pictorial rather than abstract representations of a stitch or technique.

**CHART A**

- Each square of the chart represents a stitch, and each row of squares represents a row of stitches.
- The numbers up the sides of the chart are row numbers and therefore progress from the bottom to the top like the knitted sample.
- All rows that are numbered on the right-hand side of the chart are read from that side and represent right-side rows.
- All rows that are numbered on the left-hand side of the chart are read from that side and represent wrong-side rows. It's useful to get into the habit of reading all **charts** in this way, and it's essential when working stitch patterns that are not symmetrical.

Thus, Chart A reads:

**1st row** (right side): k5, p1, k1. (Worked from right to left.)

**2nd row**: p1, k1, p5. (Worked from left to right.)

**3rd row**: k4, p1, k2. (Worked from right to left.)

**4th row**: p2, k1, p4. . . and so on, reading right-side rows from the right and wrong-side rows from the left.

- If a stitch pattern is to be worked in the round, with right-side facing, all rows are read from the right-hand side.

**CHART B**

Each symbol within a square indicates the way a stitch is worked. Initially, it may seem confusing that a blank square represents two stitches – knit on a right-side row and purl on a wrong-side row – and that a dot represents two stitches – purl on

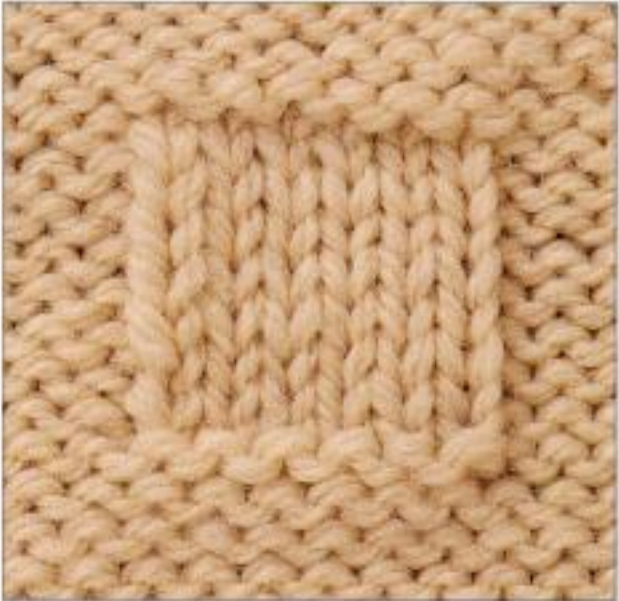
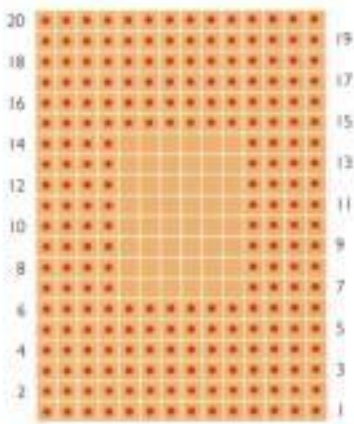

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over 9 sts on rows 6, 7, and 8 before decreasing 2 sts on both rows 9 and 11 to return to 5 sts on row 12.

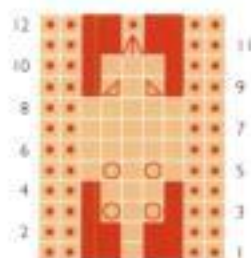


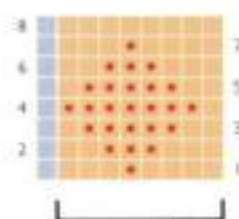

### CHART G

- An area of a chart that is unshaded and also has a bracket underneath indicates a group of stitches forming a repeat.
- A shaded area indicates stitches that are worked at the beginning or end of a row to balance the repeat.
- The number of stitches required for the repeat is given as a "Multiple of ... sts" and the number of end stitches as "plus ...".  
In Chart G, "Multiple of 8 sts plus 1" means cast on a number of stitches divisible by 8 and add 1 more.

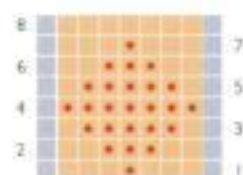

### CHARTS H AND I

An unshaded area underlined by an H-shaped bracket indicates a panel or motif, and shaded areas indicate a notional number of stitches to the sides of the pattern area. In a panel all the rows of the chart are repeated. A motif may have an odd number of rows, and any number of "background" rows may be worked below and above.



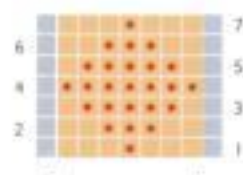

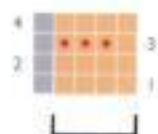

# KNIT AND PURL STITCHES

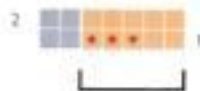
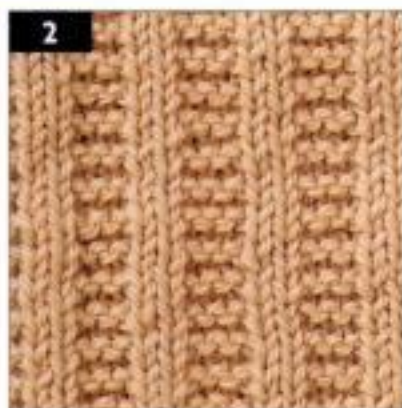
Knit and purl stitches are the basis of all knitting. On their own they offer a tremendous number of possibilities. The smoothness of the "knit" side of the stitch and the roundness of the "purl" side can be contrasted to make textures as varied as seed stitch and brocade. The stitches can be aligned vertically to make ribs or horizontally to make ridges. In turn, these can be combined to make brick patterns and basket weaves.

The very simplest knit and purl textures are sometimes overlooked, but a sweater banded with many small-repeat, grainy stitches would be very attractive. Traditional English fishermen's Guernseys decorated with knit and purl geometrics are enduring classics. Whatever the design, it's advisable to use a smooth, firm yarn and a close gauge to emphasize the contrast between smooth and raised stitches.



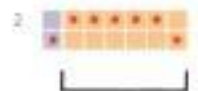
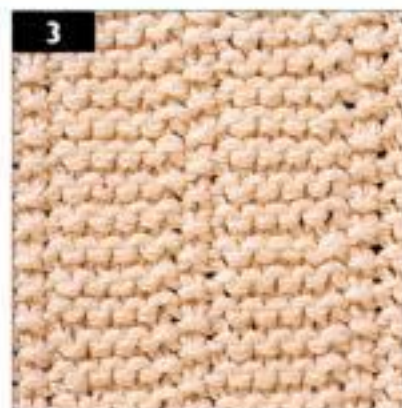

# CABLE STITCHES

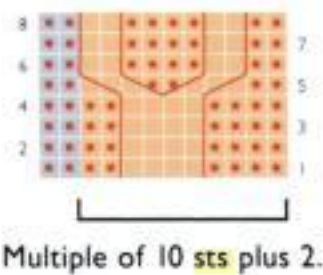
Cables are stitches that look like twisted ropes, interwoven plaits and criss-cross trellises and which seem so complicated to the uninitiated. But the principle is simple: making a cable is merely working stitches, or groups of stitches, out of sequence. A cable needle (a short, double-pointed needle, usually curved or notched) is used to hold the first stitch(es) to the front or back while working the following stitch(es); the knitting is then resumed from the cable needle. Cables are usually worked in stockinette stitch on a plain or textured ground, but they look particularly rich when they themselves are textured.

Besides raising the surface, cables contract the knitted fabric, so it's usually a good idea to work increases into the base of a cable panel or motif and decreases into the top to prevent flaring above and below. The density of the fabric makes cables ideal for outdoor wear.

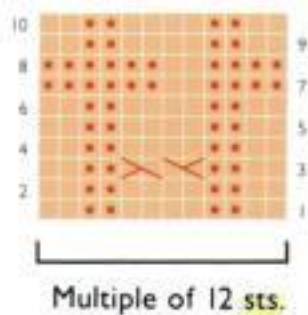




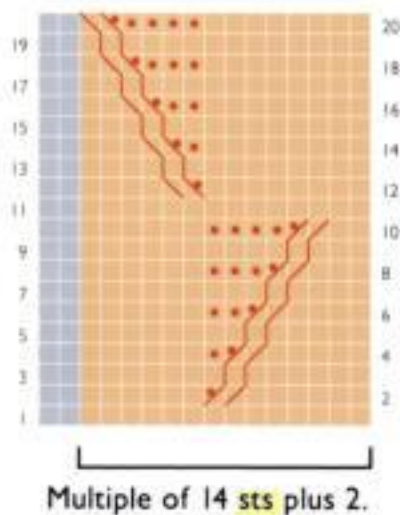

# LACE AND BOBBLE STITCHES

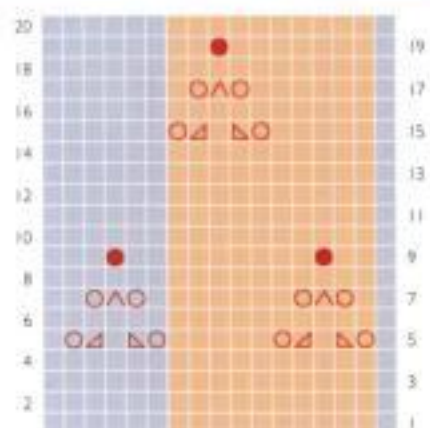
Both lace and bobble stitches are very compatible with cables and feature in the previous section. Here, I have used them together and separately, so that round, three-dimensional bobbles complement round, open eyelets.

There are many ways of making bobbles, but the basic principle I have used is that one stitch is increased into several times, the newly-formed group of stitches is then worked, and then the increased stitches are passed over the first one, which is worked again to "anchor" it. This gives a firm, round bobble without a tendency to disappear to the wrong side of the knitting. Single eyelets are made by decreasing one stitch and compensating for this with a yarn-over increase. Double eyelets are made by working two decreases with a double yarn over between. They can both be used to form an all-over lacy fabric or to define a pattern on a solid ground.

Lace stitches are usually better worked on a largish needle and in a yarn which can be blocked (that is, shaped and pinned out) and thoroughly pressed.





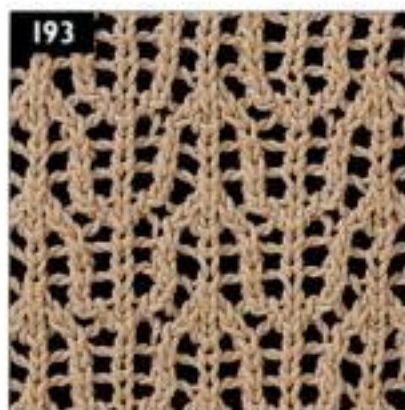

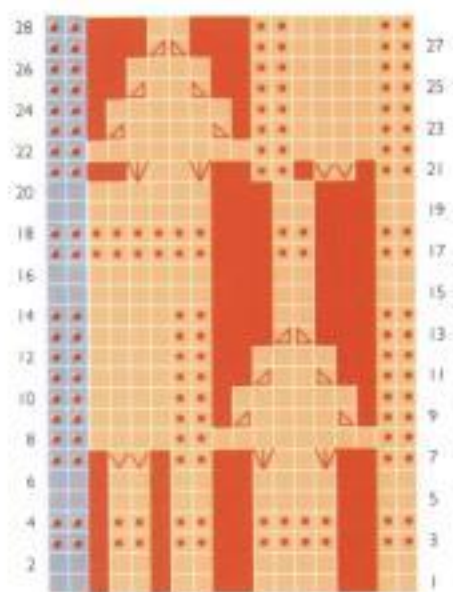

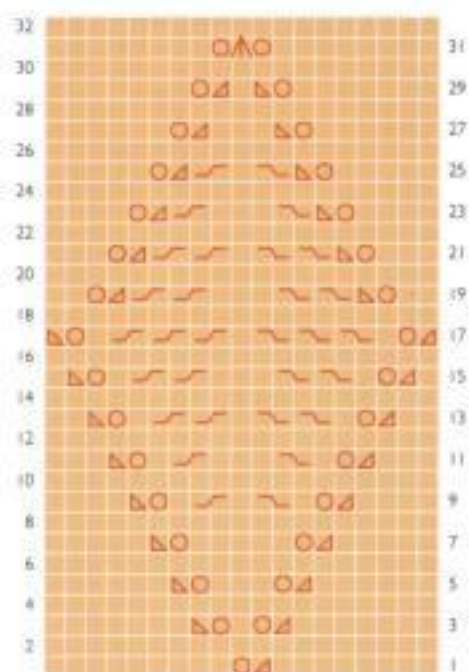

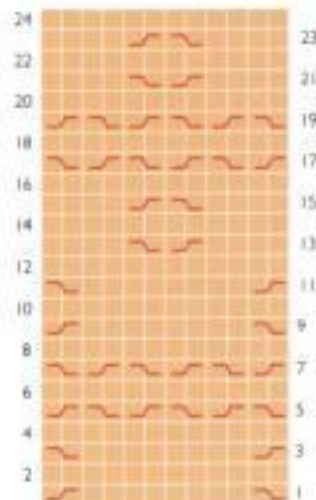

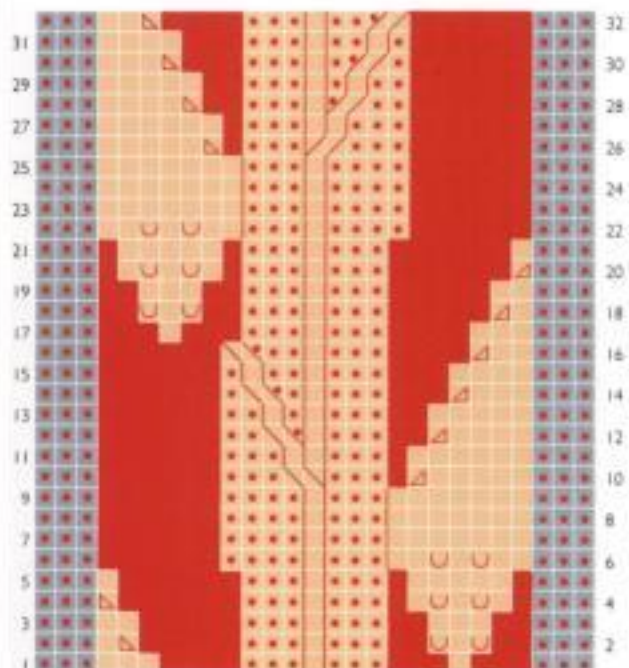

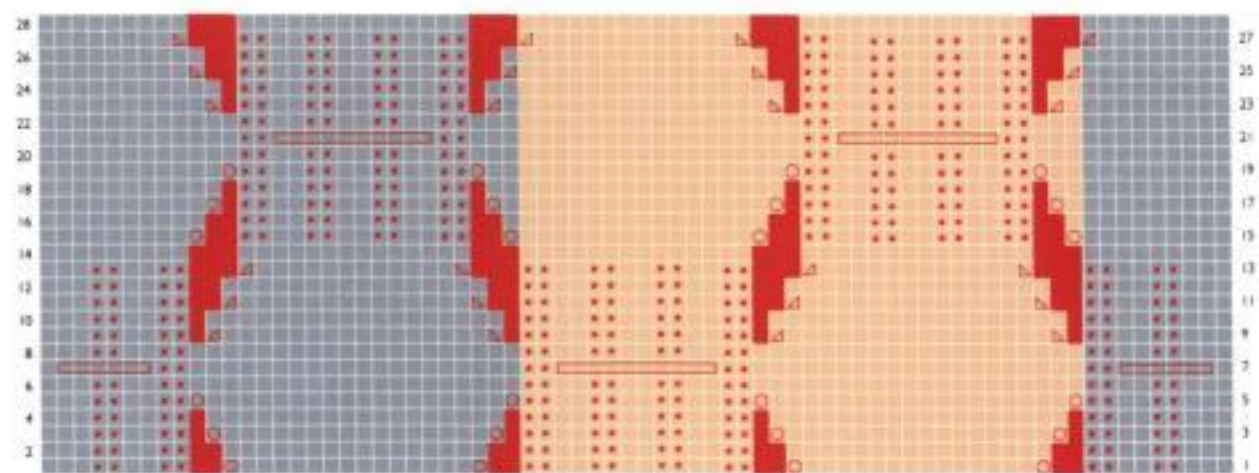

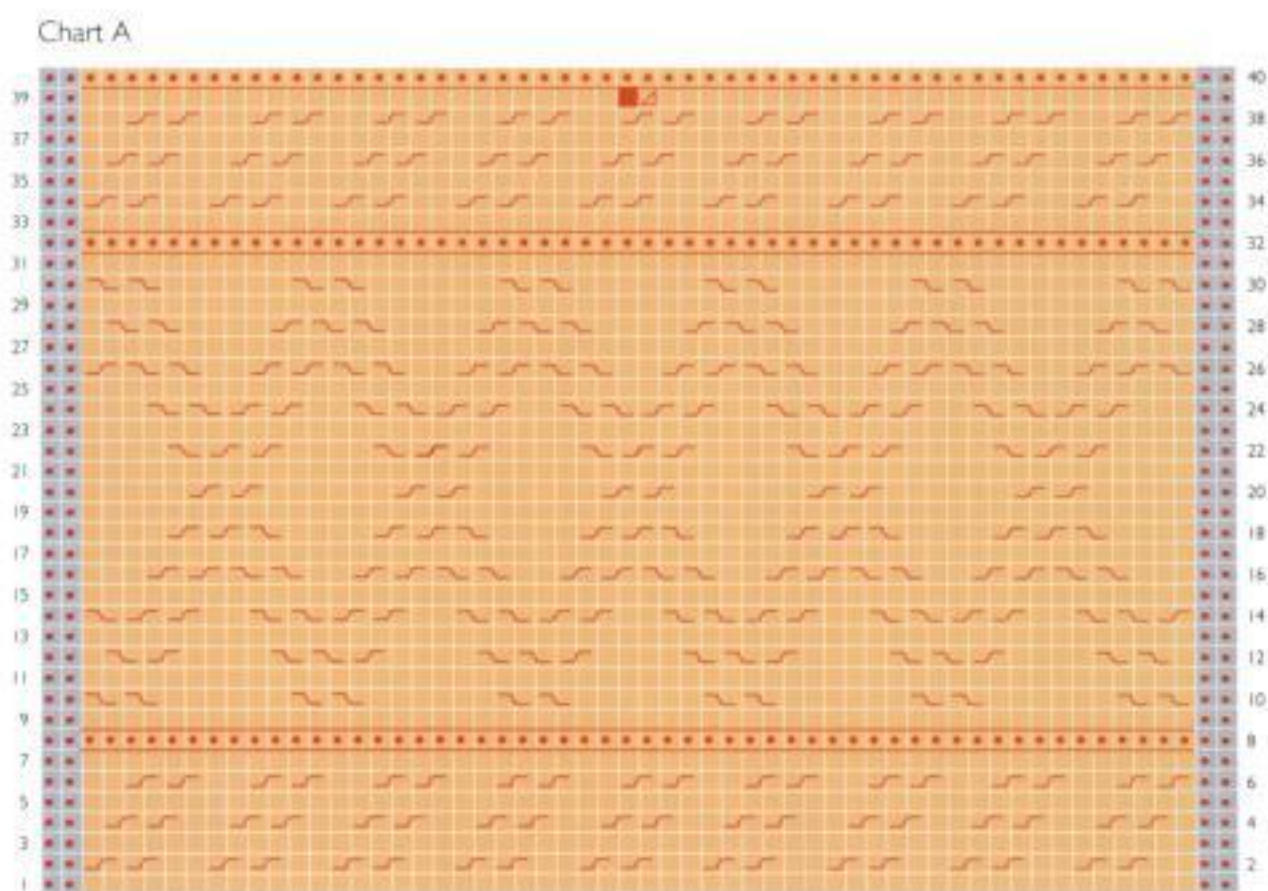


Chart A is worked first and is a motif of 54 sts, decreased to 53 sts on row 39.

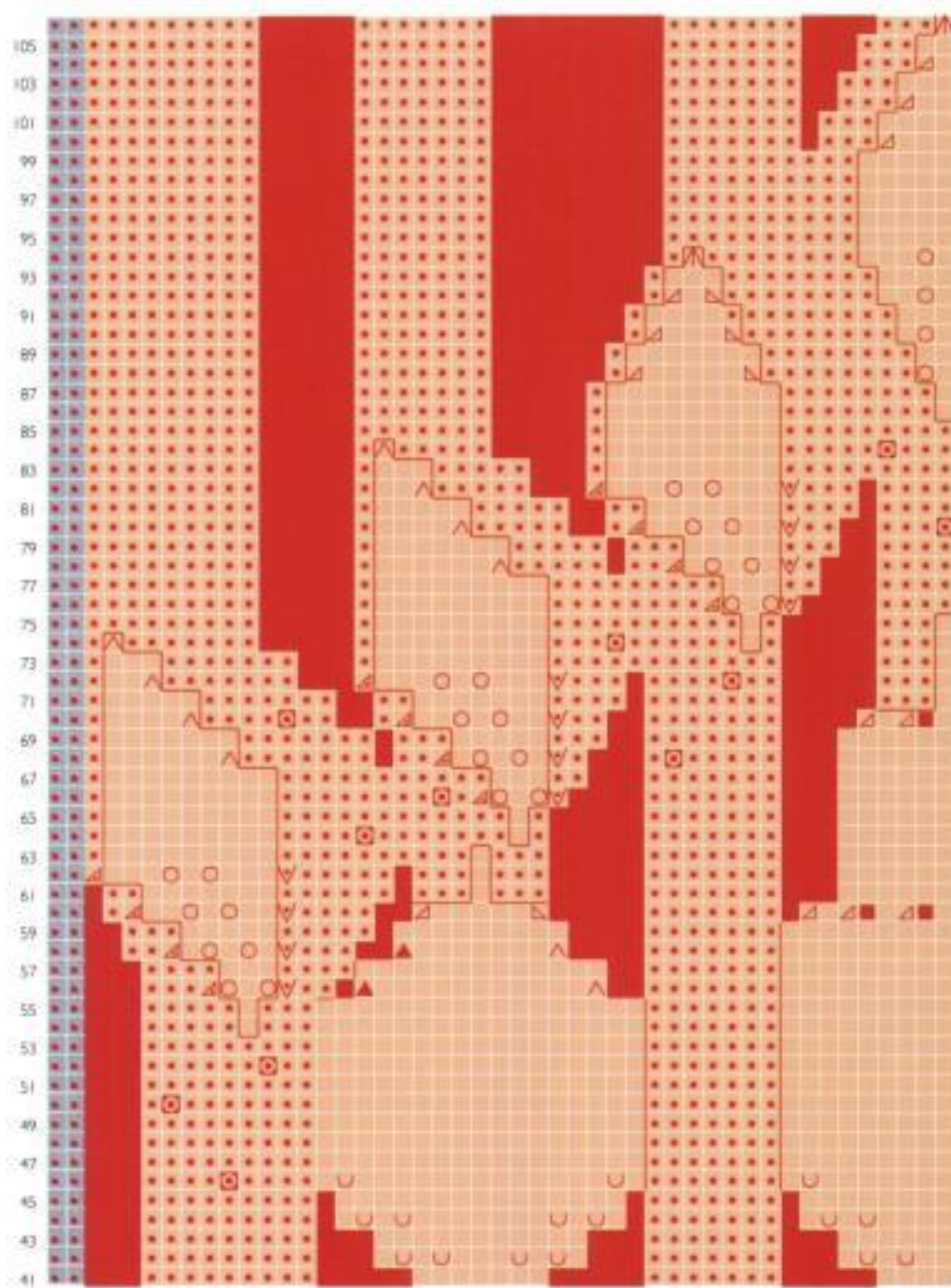
Chart B is then worked consecutively, the motif starting with 53 sts on row 41. The stitch count then varies until 53 sts are resumed on row 106.

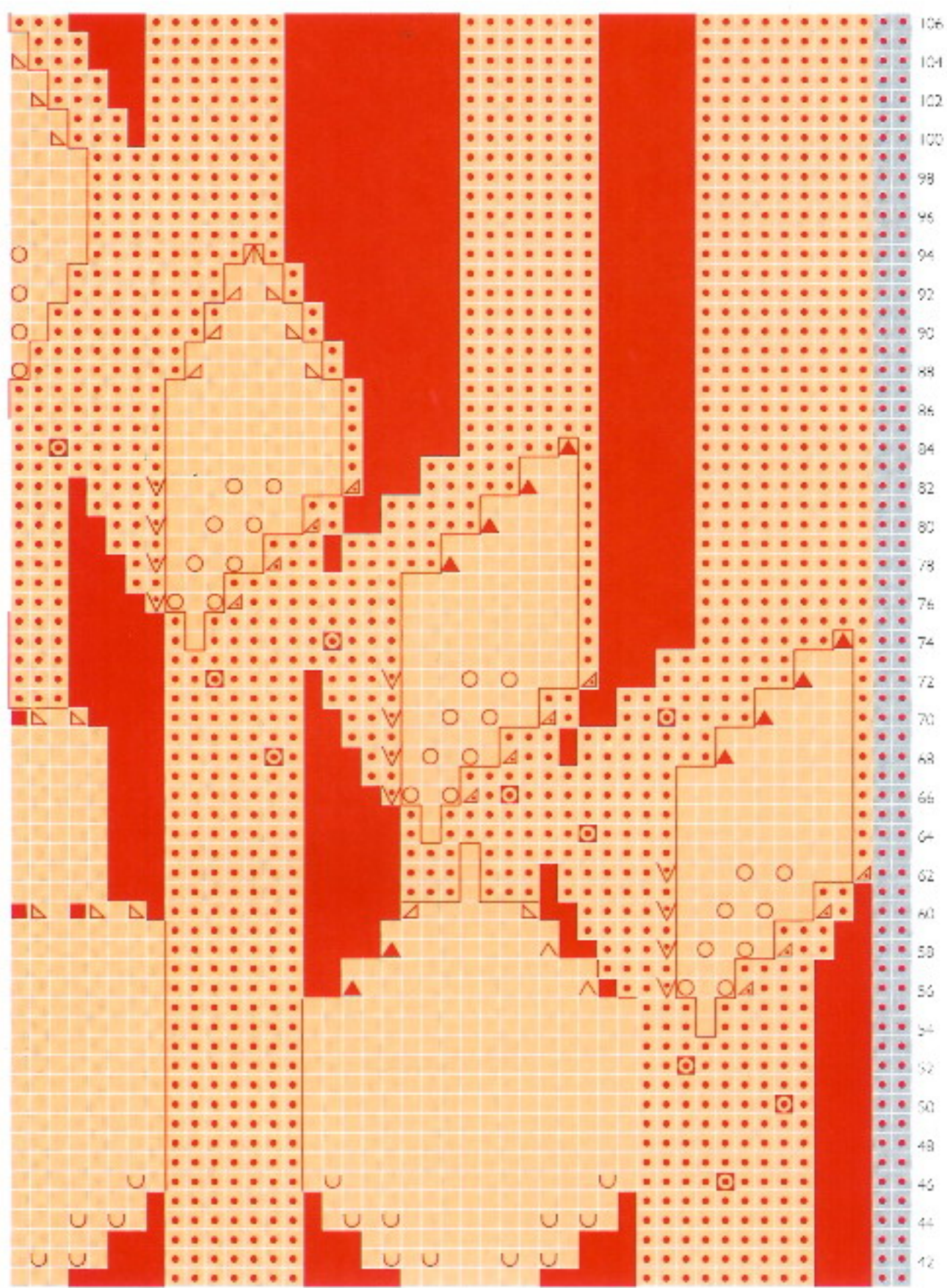
